

Good Shepherd School Awards 2014-2015

Academic Achievement

English/French Immersion Grade 4-6:

Must achieve a (4), in all outcomes (at least two, or more, outcomes must be assessed per term to qualify) for the reporting term, in any of the 6 core subjects: Language Arts, French Language Arts, Math, Science, Social Studies and Religion.

Certificates will be awarded to students for subject area, academic achievement, at the end of each reporting term, at a preselected morning school assembly.

Exceptional Academic Achievement

English/French Immersion Grade 4-6:

Must achieve a consistent grade of (4) in, all outcomes, in consecutive Terms 1, 2 and 3 in any of the 6 core subjects: Language Arts, French Language Arts, Math, Science, Social Studies and Religion.

Certificates will be awarded to students for subject area, exceptional academic achievement, at the year-end awards assembly.

Honorable Effort

Grade 1-6: For students who have put in exceptional effort toward their academic performance...

Each teacher may submit up to 3 Names per class. Certificates will be presented to all nominees at the year-end awards assembly.

Principal's Award

Grades 1-6:

The principal's award is presented to a well-rounded Div. 1 and Div. II student. Nominations are based on academic effort, and more importantly citizen and leadership in the school for his/her peers.

One nominee per grade will be recognized as a nominee and will receive a certificate. Out of those nominees, one is chosen by the principal.

Jim McIntyre –Most Improved Student Award

This award is presented to a Division I and Division II student who has shown considerable growth in their academic effort, achievement, work habits or conduct throughout the school year.

One name may be submitted per class in each grade 1-6, nominees will be recognized as a nominee by announcement during the awards ceremony. Out of those nominees, one is chosen in each Div. I and Div II.

The award winners will receive a certificate and he/she gets his/her name engraved on a plaque-

Louise Loyie Most Improved First Nation Metis Inuit (FNMI) Student Award

This award is presents to an FNMI student who has shown considerable growth in their academic effort, achievement , work habits or conduct throughout the school year.

Each teacher may nominate one FNMI student, per class, in each grade level. Out of those nominees one is chosen. nominees will be recognized as a nominee by announcement during the awards ceremony.

The award winner gets a certificate, his/her name engraved on a school plaque and is presented with an individual plaque (and can be presented with FNMI memorabilia.)

Sue McGowan Christian Leadership Award

This award is presented to a Division II student who demonstrates strong Christian leadership throughout the year. This student is a positive influence on their peers, helps their peers develop their own talents and serves others in our school and community.

One name may be submitted per class in each grade nominees will be recognized as a nominee by announcement during the awards ceremony. Out of those nominees, one is chosen.

The award winner gets his/her name engraved on a school plaque and is presented with an individual plaque.

Noel Cairney “Light Your Candle” Award

This award is given to a Division I student in the school who shows Christian Leadership by going out of their way to be friendly and courteous to their peers, staff and visitors to the school. This student thinks of others before themselves and serves others in our school.. One name may be submitted per class in Division I . Nominees will be recognized as a nominee by announcement during the awards ceremony. Out of those nominees, one is chosen.

The award winner gets a certificate, his/her name engraved on a school plaque and is presented with an individual plaque.

Rose Lizotte-Briscoe First Nation Metis Inuit (FNMI) Leadership Award

This award is presented to a Grade 5 or 6 FNMI student who demonstrates strong leadership skills. Each grade 5 and 6 teacher nominates one FNMI student per class. Out of those nominees

one is chosen. Nominees will be recognized as a nominee by announcement during the awards ceremony.

The award winner received a certificate gets his/her name engraved on a school plaque and is presented with an individual plaque.

Esther Siry Award

This award is given to two French Immersion students, one in Division I and one in Division II, in the school who consistently demonstrate an interest in French during the school year by speaking and reading French as well as encouraging others in their class to speak French.

One name may be submitted per class in each grade, nominees will be recognized as a nominee by announcement during the awards ceremony. . Out of those nominees, one is chosen.

The award winner gets a certificate and his/her name engraved on a school plaque and is presented with an individual plaque.

Gr. 6 Music Achievement Award

This award is given to a Gr. 6 band student, and is selected by the grade 6 band teacher(s). Nominees will be recognized by announcement during the awards ceremony.

The award winner gets a certificate, his/her name engraved on a school plaque and is presented with an individual plaque.

Calum Farmer Memorial Fine Arts Award

This award is presented to a Division I and a Division II student who demonstrates a love for the arts. Students who demonstrate skill in dramatic arts, dance, music ministry, choir and creative arts in the school should be considered.

One name may be submitted per class in each grade, nominees will be recognized as a nominee by announcement during the awards ceremony. Out of those nominees, one is chosen.

Winners will get a certificate their names on a plaque which remains at the school.

Sportsmanship Award

This award is presented to a Division I and a Division II student who best displays sportsmanship in athletics, playground leadership and in physical education classes.

One name may be submitted per class in each grade, nominees will be recognized by announcement during the awards ceremony. Out of those nominees, one is chosen.

The winner will get a certificate and his or her name on a plaque which will remain at the school.
